Participants:

Every nation has the right to send to the competition:

6 players men

4 players women

3 players juniors, male

3 players juniors, female

3 players oldtimers, male

3 players oldtimers, female

Note that these are the maximum amounts of players allowed in each category from each country. If there are, for instance, also oldtimers playing in men's or women's team, no more than 3 male and 3 female oldtimers can play the

individual competition in that category, the rest must participate in men's or women's category in the individual competition.

Team competition: 6 players men's team

4 players women's team

4 players junior team (including at least one player from each gender)

4 players oldtimers team (including at least one player from each gender)

In men's team competition the 5 best scores of the team in each playing round are counted. In all other team competitions the 3 best scores of the team in each round are counted.

Tournament mode: All participants play 4 rounds on Saturday, and 2 rounds on Sunday. Team competition ends after 6 rounds. The best players of each category qualify to the 2 final rounds:

9 players men, 6 players women, 6 players male juniors, 6 players female juniors, 6 players male oldtimers, 6 players female oldtimers. Players with the same result as the last qualifier are also qualified for the final.

Rules & antidoping: The worldwide international sport rules of WMF including supplementary rules and worldwide international sport regulations are applied for the Nordic Championships. Each participant must accept the WMF anti-doping regulations in current version. Sport shoes and uniform team sports clothing appropriate for minigolf are required during official practice time and tournament. Only sports hats are allowed.
